1. Ramadan How to guide my child through this

Our colleagues from North East Gelderland have made this leaflet for parents.

Ramadan is the ninth month of the Islamic lunar calendar. This is the month of repentance, where fasting takes place between sunrise and sunset. Although young children are not required to fast during Ramadan, your child may have the desire to join in. It is also important to take this desire seriously. How do you guide your child to do so in the best way possible?

2. About schurft (ook wel: scabiës)

GPs are seeing more patients with scabies than usual since October 2021: especially in the 15-24 age group. But scabies also occurs among younger children.



Scabies is caused by the scabies mite, a tiny creature you cannot see with the naked eye. The mite digs tunnels in the surface of the skin and lays eggs there. The skin then gives an allergic reaction to the mite, causing itching.

How can scabies be recognised?

- Itching that gets progressively worse
- Blisters and red bumps, especially between the fingers, wrists and feet.
- Sometimes you can see a red stripe on the skin. These are the passageways the mite digs.
- Young children up to 4 years old can also get itching and bumps on the head.

How do you get scabies?

- You can get scabies from someone else who has scabies in the following ways:
- Skin contact for more than 15 minutes with someone who has scabies.
- Wearing clothes and/or using the same towels of someone who has scabies.
- Sleeping in the same bed as someone who has scabies
